



HOW TO USE LAWSUIT ANALYZER[©]

- **READ EVERY SINGLE WORD.**
- [Click Here to Print these Instructions.](#) You will need them.
- **There is no time limit**, so take your time. You can complete some then come back days later, etc.
- **If you are using a mobile device**, click **HIDE STEPS** to hide the program phases when you see the questions.
- **You must answer each question** to move ahead to the next.
- **Click on the Help Button** on each page for in-depth information to assist you. Each Help page opens in the same browser tab, so you return to the program using your browser back button or the Maroon X Close button at the top right of each Help Page (see it on this page).
- **Click the up or down arrow** in the lower right corner to move back and forth. When you go back, you can change your input. Any changes will immediately update the program and will be saved.
- **You can also use the Navigation Bar** to move back and forth through phases.
- **If you don't like your outcome** in Phase 5, 6 or 7 go back and revise your answers in Phase 1-4, then click on Phase 5, 6 or 7 to see how your results were impacted.
- **You can continue this back and forth process** until you enter your email address and click Go To in Phase 7 at which time the program will end and your results will be emailed to you.
- **When you complete the program**, you will be directed to the page for the forum indicated for your dispute which will then guide you through the steps ahead.
- **You received TWO links** to Lawsuit Analyzer[®], so there are many ways to re-analyze your dispute.
